Teams cleared gardens for local residents and helped with various diy projects. There were also teams removing graffiti and painting fences.

The 3 day event culminated in a fun afternoon on the local green with free inflatables, candy floss, face painting and other activities. John and Carol served us so well by preparing all the food for the BBQ. Throughout the course of the afternoon 192 burgers, 80 hot dogs and 70 pies were served in all. There were over 300 adults and children on the green!
